The Kids-N-Hope Foundation is a charitable organization that supports the Music Therapy Program for children at the Children's Seashore House of the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia. The Music Therapy Program allows children to express themselves while interacting and supporting other children in the hospital. Since 1996, American Heritage has donated over \$1,000,000 to CHOP to support the Music Therapy program.

The Radiothon is just one of many events American Heritage participates in to help raise money for this program. The next Kids-N-Hope event is the 20th Annual Golf Classic, which will be held at PineCrest Country Club on October 12, 2015.
