American Heritage Federal Credit Union Hosts Their 20th Annual Golf Classic Raising Over \$30,000 for the Kids-N-Hope Foundation

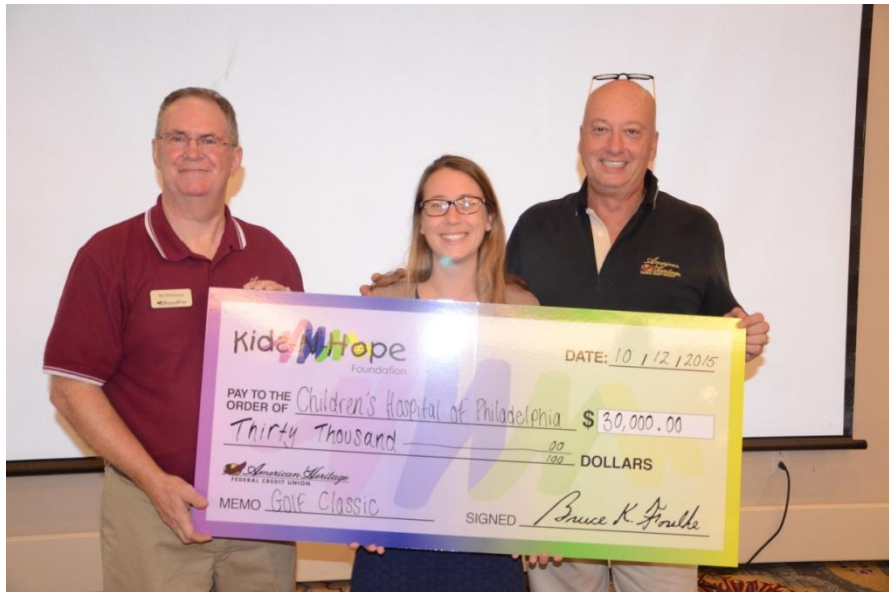
